


## Summary of 2013 AOTULE Program at Tokyo Tech

## Outline:

- 3-month (Jun. 3 to Aug. 30) summer exchange research program
- Participants:
  - 15 MS + PhD students (9 AOTULE Univ. missing ITB)

## Activities:

- Research Project (main activity for the students):
  - At host professor's research group in the Tokyo Tech Graduate School of Engineering
- Course works:
  - "Survival Japanese": One week, morning session of very basic "survival Japanese" lectures for those who are permitted to attend based on the placement test of Japanese proficiency
  - "HighTech Japan": Lectures by engineers/researchers from industry + factory/facility tour



- MISW = Multidisciplinary International Student Workshop at Tokyo Tech
- Oral presentation of research / Poster to introduce their home institutions
- Certificates (optional)
  - Certificate of the period of enrollment as an International Exchange Student
  - Certificate of Research (based upon evaluation of their activities)
  - Academic Records (score sheet for course works)

## Evaluation:

- Web questionnaire after the programme
- High satisfaction, over all
  - 12 out of 13 chose the highest rating
- Comments and suggestions
  - Period too short (3 months) for research -> apply for other programs?
